Working with the Director of Sustainable Finance, the principal duties and responsibilities of the position will involve:

- Helping to develop T&E's priorities for/positions on legislative files in the fields of sustainable finance and EU spending.
- Meeting policymakers to present T&E positions and relevant research.
- Developing coalitions of likeminded stakeholders on various legislative priorities.
- Tracking EU policy-making and developing strategies that coincide with legislative opportunities.
